1st – 6th Grade SERVICE HOURS St. Anthony's Religious Education Program

All grades 1st through 6th are required to complete 3 Community Service Hours. All of the hours must be supervised and verified by an adult. The service hours should not be for your own pet or animal, not for a for-profit business, and should not be for family members. ONLY young students (1-3rd Grade) can earn hours by doing chores at home. Students cannot be compensated for their service.

Opportunities for earning service hours will be emailed to families as we hear of them.

Suggestions for individual and Community service hours are listed below:

- ONLY primary students (1st-3rd Grade) can earn hours by doing chores at home/for family members
 - Students in 2nd and 3rd Grade are strongly encouraged to reach beyond their family/chores when completing volunteer hours.
- Collect and/or organize a food drive for a food pantry the St. Vincent DePaul group collects once a month
- Volunteer at a local homeless shelter Joliet Diocese has a Daybreak Homeless shelter where volunteers can cook and serve food to the homeless
- Taking care of the needs of a neighbor yard work, cleaning their house, shopping, making them a meal or cookies etc
- 10 Handmade, neatly done, signed, cards for service members or nursing home residents equal one service hour
- Make a Project Linus fleece blanket for nursing home residents https://www.projectlinus.org/patterns/pdf/NoSewFB.pdf
- Visiting and/or playing games (bingo, scrabble etc) with patients at local nursing homes
- Community service helping out a local hospital, visiting the sick, Special Olympics, Caritas, Family Abuse Center
